Choose an interval that lets you make the graph as large as possible

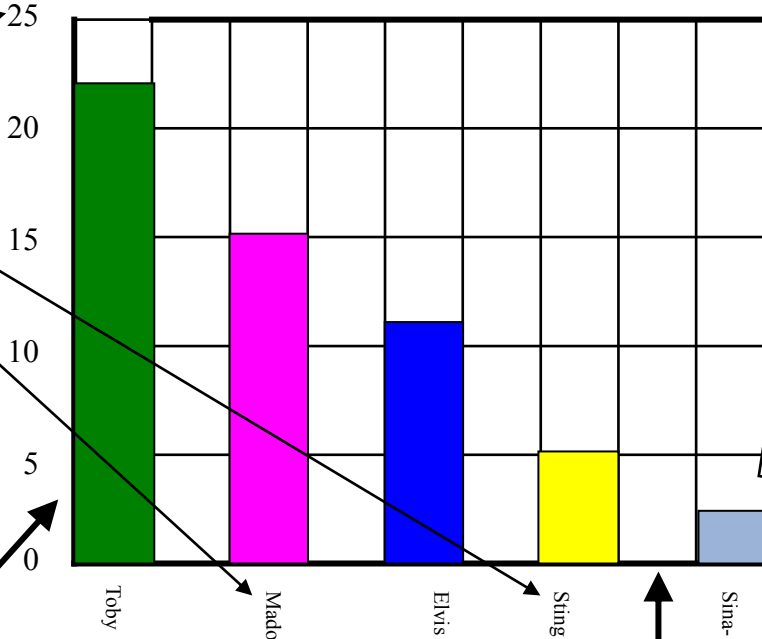
Title

- When to use a bar graphs**
- Used to show data that are not continuous.
 - Allows us to compare data like amounts or frequency or categories
 - Allow us to make generalizations about the data
 - Help us see differences in data
- Line Graphs**
- For continuous data
 - useful for showing trends over time
